## RE: Larry W. Fultz Award for Excellence

Annually, the Texas Association of College and University Police Administrators (TACUPA) presents the Larry W. Fultz Award for Excellence to an outstanding campus police or security officer. The award was established to recognize personnel who demonstrate the intrinsic value of law enforcement and security personnel on higher education campuses. The successful nominee should demonstrate a devotion to education, service and professional standing of higher education law enforcement or security.

The selected recipient will be presented an award plaque and a check for \$500.

This award is named in honor of Larry W. Fultz, who served as an Inspector for the City of Houston Police Department, Chief of the Harris County Juvenile Probation Department, and Director of Security at the University of Houston. Throughout his career he was a stalwart advocate of higher education policing in the State of Texas.

Eligibility criteria and submission guidelines include:

- Any person employed as a full-time peace officer or security officer at a higher education institution whose department has at least one employee that is a member of TACUPA.
- Chief Administrative Officers are not eligible.
- Each nomination should include a narrative, no more than two pages in length, outlining the nominee's service to their department and their college or university.
- The nomination may be submitted by anyone but must be endorsed by the Department's Chief Administrative Officer.

- Submission deadline is October 31 for that year's award to be presented in December.

**Note: The 2020 Award Nomination deadline has been extended through March 31, 2021. The 2020 Award presentation will be in May 2021.**
